



2023 Devils Lake Youth Basketball Tournament 7th & 8th Grade

Rules & Regulations

- All teams must register at the DL Sports Center (1601 College Dr N / West Door)
- All teams must submit a roster and no changes are allowed after a team has checked in.
- Teams are given wristbands for the players listed on their rosters (up to 10) and 2 coaches wristbands.
- Players must compete in their own grade division unless they are playing up. Players may only play on one team per grade. Teams must register in the division of their highest-grade player.
- All teams must have uniform shirts with printed visible numbers.
- Every team is guaranteed 3 games. Game time is forfeit time. A forfeit is considered a guaranteed game. Be at gym 45 Minutes before scheduled game time in case games are running ahead.
- Teams provide their own basketballs to warm-up with. Warm-up time and half-times will be 3 Minutes or adjusted to keep on schedule.
- 3rd- 9th grade girls and boys will play (2) 18-minute halves. 1 time-out per half (no carry-over). Substitution allowed on dead ball situations. Clock will run continuously, except for time-outs. Clock will stop with normal timing regulations for the last 2 minutes of the game if the score is within 10 points or less.
- 7th – 8th grade- may full court press.
- 7th – 8th may play any type of Defense.
- **No Dunking in warmups or games.**
- Overtime will be 2 minutes, with clock stopping as in regular play. Each team will get one timeout. Second overtime will be sudden death in grades 5th-9th. 3rd and 4th boys and girls second overtime will be a free throw contest with each team shooting 5 free throws. If still tied Coin flip.
- Women's Ball will be used for Boys and Girl's grades 3rd-6th. Men's ball will be used for Boy's grade 7th-9th.
- Failure to maintain a competitive environment could result in the immediate ending of a game and disqualification from the tournament and future DLYABT events.
- No Protests- Officials' decisions are final.
- Tournament score book and score clock is official.
- Use good sportsmanship. Athletes, parents, coaches, and fans are all required to follow this rule. Anyone showing excessive unsportsmanlike behavior towards tournament officials, scorekeepers or other tournament volunteers will be asked to leave.
- Daily admission is \$6.00 per adult; \$4.00 for kids 6 & older. Admission is for all day, at any gym.
